



Obtaining a children's library card for use at public libraries in Örebro

Children and young people under the age of 15 must have the consent of a parent or guardian before they can obtain a library card. Read through the borrowing rules, fill in the details on the form, sign it, and hand it in at the library. A parent or guardian is always responsible for anything their child may borrow, even during school hours.

Borrowing rules for children and young people – 0-14 years

- The loan period for books is normally 28 days. The period can vary – details can be found on the loan receipt.
- Borrowing books from the library is free of charge.
- Your library card must not be lent to anyone else.
- Your library card is valid at all public libraries in the municipality of Örebro.
- If you lose your library card, it must be blocked immediately. Inform the staff at the library.
- A new library card can be issued on payment of a fee.
- There is no overdue charge for children's books, although a charge is payable if a reminder is sent out. There is always an overdue charge for video games, even for children.
- If a book is not returned on time, or if it is damaged or lost, the borrower's parent or guardian is liable for the cost of replacement.
- If the right to borrow is misused, this could result in the borrower being temporarily excluded from using the library's services.
